Recognizing the Signs of Hearing Loss

Signs of hearing loss can develop slowly over time, or they can begin suddenly. Struggling to hear certain sounds or syllables is a telltale sign of hearing loss.

An estimated 30 million Americans suffer from hearing loss and could benefit from using hearing aids.¹ Left untreated, hearing loss can have significant effects on communication abilities, quality of life, social participation and overall health.

How Can You Treat Hearing Loss?

Hearing loss is a common condition, with many treatment options to restore one of your key senses. Treatment is dependent upon the type of hearing loss and individual's hearing needs. To determine your best course of care, schedule an appointment with a local hearing provider who will make recommendations based on:

- 1 Your type of hearing loss
- 2 Your degree of hearing loss
- 3 The cause(s) of hearing loss, if known
- 4 Your lifestyle, interests and communication needs
- 5 Your cosmetic preferences and budget
