Essilor® Stellest® Ordering Guide For VBA

Essilor® Stellest® lens is utilized for Pediatric Myopia Management. Eyeglass lenses designed to slow progression of pediatric myopia, including Essilor® Stellest® spectacle lenses, can be dispensed to VBA members if it is designated as non-covered in the VBA Provider Portal.

Ordering Requirements

The process for ordering Stellest lenses through the VBA Provider Portal will be much like ordering any other pair of glasses. Stellest lenses are broken into the following components and must be ordered together:

- Essilor Stellest
- Single Vision Lens
- Polycarbonate Material
- Premium Anti-Reflective Coating (Crizal® Easy^{PRO})
- Digital Surfacing (Essilor 360° Fit™)

Follow-Up Policy

Essilor® Stellest® lens dispensing includes a maximum of one (1) follow-up visit within ninety (90) days of the initial frame fitting for the purpose of frame adjustments. All subsequent follow-up visits are the sole responsibility of the Member and shall be considered non-covered, private pay transactions. Prescription rechecks, lens remakes and other aspects of a myopia management program are considered private pay transactions and are the sole responsibility of the Member.
